The hearing will be conducted before the Veterinary Medical Board, Department of Consumer Affairs and an administrative law judge of the Office of Administrative Hearings, who will preside over the Petition for Reinstatement matter.

If you object to the petition being heard by videoconference, you must notify the presiding officer within ten (10) days after this notice is served on you. Failure to notify the presiding officer within ten (10) days will deprive you of a change in the place of hearing.

You may be present at the hearing. You have the right to be represented by an attorney at your own expense. You are not entitled to the appointment of an attorney to represent you at public expense. You are entitled to represent yourself without legal counsel. You may present any relevant evidence and will be given full opportunity to cross-examine all witnesses testifying against you. You are entitled to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of books, documents, or other things by applying to:

INTREPRETER: Pursuant to section 11435.20 of the Government Code, the hearing shall be conducted in English language. If a party or party’s witness does not proficiently speak or

understand the English language and before commencement of the hearing requests language assistance, an agency subject to the language assistance requirement in section 11435.15 of the Government Code shall provide a certified interpreter or an interpreter approved by the administrative law judge conducting the proceedings. The cost of providing the interpreter shall be paid by the agency having jurisdiction over the matter if the administrative law judge or hearing officer so directs, otherwise by the party for whom the interpreter is provided. If you or a witness requires the assistance of an interpreter, ample advance notice of this fact should be given to the Office of Administrative Hearings so that appropriate arrangements can be made.

CONTINUANCES: Under section 11524 of the Government Code, the agency may grant a continuance, but when an administrative law judge of the Office of Administrative Hearings has been assigned to the hearing, no continuance may be granted except by him or her or by the presiding judge for good cause. When seeking a continuance, a party shall apply for the continuance within 10 working days following the time the party discovered or reasonably should have discovered the event or occurrence which establishes good cause for the continuance. A continuance may be granted for good cause after the 10 working days have lapsed only if the party seeking the continuance is not responsible for and has made a good faith effort to prevent the condition or even establishing the good cause.

After serving my conviction with community service (50 hours), a 5-year probation (June 22, 2015) to the court, and a 1-year probation (June 30, 2016) with the Veterinary Medical Board, I decided to start my life over.

I have learned from my previous mistakes, due to the lack of knowledge and experience in the roofing business, so I made the smart decision by giving up the family roofing company. I have focused all of my time and efforts to pursue my career as licensed veterinary technician, so I found a part time job at a veterinary hospital as a veterinary assistant, but not without extreme difficulties. I suffer terribly from rheumatoid arthritis, a debilitating disease, I acquired at 15-years of age. Though I suffered so much in my life with this disease due to constant excruciating pain, my love and passion in the veterinary medical, kept me going and never giving up. I started my first job as a kennel aid at the age of 16. Then, I started to train as a veterinary assistant for veterinary technicians and Veterinarians. At that time, I did not know that veterinary schools accommodated people with disabilities, so I decided to go in the other direction and become a Registered Veterinary Technician. So, I enrolled at San Diego Mesa College and received my Associates of Science Degree in Animal Health Technology. After graduating from school, I signed up to take my State Board Exams in Sacramento, CA. After I received my exam results from the VMB, stating that I passed, I cried. It was the happiest day of my life, because the program and state exams were not easy.

After I surrendered my RVT license, I continued taking continuing education classes to stay current. My passion for always wanting to learn, says a lot about who I am as a person. I currently work for ABC Veterinary Hospital Uptown in San Diego, CA, as a veterinary technician assistant. I love taking care of my patients, and helping my coworkers who are new to the veterinary field. I believe that I am an important asset to the Veterinary Medical field.

But I have accepted if the Veterinary Medical Board does not grant and reinstate my license, then I will continue working in the field as a veterinary assistant. But if given the opportunity for a second chance, then I would like to further my education and major as a VTS in Anesthetic and Analgesia, as long as my health permits.

I thank the Veterinary Medical Board for allowing me to have the opportunity to request to have my license reinstated as a Registered Veterinary Technician in the state of California.

26 3. On or about August 9, 2004, the Veterinary Medical Board issued Registered
27 Veterinary Technician License No. TEC 6555 to Susie Del Castillo Aviles (Respondent). The

1 Registered Veterinary Technician License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the
2 charges brought in Accusation No. AA 2015 40 and expired on December 31, 2015.

3 JURISDICTION

4 4. Accusation No. AA 2015 40 was filed before the Veterinary Medical Board (Board),
5 Department of Consumer Affairs, and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation
6 and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on September 9,
7 2015. Respondent timely filed her Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of

9 ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

10 5. Respondent has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the

12 discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender of License and
13 Order.

14 6. Respondent is fully aware of her legal rights in this matter, including the right to a





20 **PARTIES**

21 1. Annemarie Del Mugnaio (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in her official
22 capacity as the Executive Officer of the Veterinary Medical Board, Department of Consumer
23 Affairs.

24 2. On or about August 9, 2004, the Veterinary Medical Board issued Registered
25 Veterinary Technician License Number TEC 6555 to Susie Del Castillo Aviles (Respondent).
26 The Registered Veterinary Technician License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to
27 the charges brought herein and will expire on December 31, 2015, unless renewed.

28 ///

1 **JURISDICTION**

2 3. This Accusation is brought before the Veterinary Medical Board (Board), Department
3 of Consumer Affairs, under the authority of the following laws. All section references are to the
4 Business and Professions Code (Code) unless otherwise indicated.

5 4. Section 118(b) of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the suspension, expiration,
6 surrender, or cancellation of a license shall not deprive the Board of its authority to institute or
7 continue with a disciplinary proceeding during the period within which the license may be
8 renewed, restored, reissued or reinstated. Pursuant to section 4902 of the Code, the Board may
9 renew a license within five years of its expiration.

10 5. Section 4875 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the board may revoke or
11 suspend for a certain time the license or registration of any person to practice veterinary medicine
12 or any branch thereof in this state after notice and hearing for any of the causes provided in this
13 article. In addition to its authority to suspend or revoke a license or registration, the board shall
14 have the authority to assess a fine not in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) against a
15 licensee or registrant for any of the causes specified in Section 4883. A fine may be assessed in
16 lieu of or in addition to a suspension or revocation.

17 **STATUTORY PROVISIONS**

18 6. Section 482 of the Code states:

19 Each board under the provisions of this code shall develop criteria to evaluate
20 the rehabilitation of a person when:

21 (a) Considering the denial of a license by the board under Section 480; or

22 (b) Considering suspension or revocation of a license under Section 490.

23 Each board shall take into account all competent evidence of rehabilitation
furnished by the applicant or licensee.

24 7. Section 490 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that a board may suspend or
25 revoke a license on the ground that the licensee has been convicted of a crime substantially
26 related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of the business or profession for which the
27 license was issued.

28 ///

1 8. Section 493 of the Code states:

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in a proceeding conducted by a
3 board within the department pursuant to law to deny an application for a license or to
4 suspend or revoke a license or otherwise take disciplinary action against a person who
5 holds a license, upon the ground that the applicant or the licensee has been convicted
6 of a crime substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of the
7 licensee in question, the record of conviction of the crime shall be conclusive
8 evidence of the fact that the conviction occurred, but only of that fact, and the board
9 may inquire into the circumstances surrounding the commission of the crime in order
10 to fix the degree of discipline or to determine if the conviction is substantially related
11 to the qualifications, functions, and duties of the licensee in question.

12 As used in this section, "license" includes "certificate," "permit," "authority,"
13 and "registration."

14 9. Section 4883 of the Code states:

15 The board may deny, revoke, or suspend a license or registration or assess a
16 fine as provided in Section 4875 for any of the following:

17 (a) Conviction of a crime substantially related to the qualifications, functions,
18 or duties of veterinary medicine, surgery, or dentistry, in which case the record of the
19 conviction shall be conclusive evidence.

20
21 (o) Violation, or the assisting or abetting violation, of any regulations adopted
22 by the board pursuant to this chapter. . . .

23 10. Section 4885 of the Code states:

24 A plea or verdict of guilty or a conviction following a plea of nolo contendere
25 made to a charge of a felony or of any offense related to the practice of veterinary
26 medicine or the practice of a veterinary technician is deemed to be a conviction
27 within the meaning of this article. The board may order the license or registration to
28 be suspended or revoked, or assess a fine as provided in Section 4883 or may decline
to issue a license or registration, when the time for appeal has elapsed, or the
judgment of conviction has been affirmed on appeal or when an order granting
probation is made suspending the imposition of sentence, irrespective of a subsequent
order under the provisions of Section 1203.4, 1210.1, or 3063.1 of the Penal Code
allowing that person to withdraw his or her plea of guilty and to enter a plea of not
guilty, or setting aside the verdict of guilty, or dismissing the accusation, information,
or indictment.

REGULATORY PROVISIONS

11. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 2007 states:

If the board or its designee asks an applicant or licensee to provide criminal
history information, a licensee shall respond to that request within 30 days. The
applicant or licensee shall make available all documents and other records requested
and shall respond with accurate information.

1 12. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 2040 states:

2 For the purposes of denial, suspension, or revocation of a license pursuant to
3 Division 1.5 (commencing with Section 475) of the code, a crime or act shall be
4 considered to be substantially related to the qualifications, functions or duties of a
5 person holding a license under Chapter 11 of Division 2 of the code if to a substantial
6 degree it evidences present or potential unfitness of a person holding a license to
perform the functions authorized by his or her license in a manner consistent with the
public health, safety or welfare. Such crimes or acts shall include but not be limited to
those involving the following:

7 (a) Violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or
8 abetting the violation of, or conspiring to violate any provision or term of Chapter 11,
9 Division 2 of the code.

(b) Conviction of a crime involving fiscal dishonesty.

10 13. California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 2041, subdivision (b) states:

11 (b) When considering the suspension or revocation of a license on the ground
12 that a person holding a license under Chapter 11 of Division 2 of the code has been
13 convicted of a crime, the board, shall in evaluating the rehabilitation of such person
and his or her eligibility for a license will consider the following criteria:

14 (1) Nature and severity of the act(s) or offense(s).

15 (2) Total criminal record.

16 (3) The time that has elapsed since commission of the act(s) or offense(s).

17 (4) Whether the licensee has complied with any terms of parole, probation,
restitution or any other sanctions lawfully imposed against the licensee.

18 (5) If applicable, evidence of expungement proceedings pursuant to Section
19 1203.4 of the Penal Code.

20 (6) Evidence, if any, of rehabilitation submitted by the licensee.

21 COSTS

22 14. Section 125.3 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may request the
23 administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of
24 the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and
25 enforcement of the case, with failure of the licentiate to comply subjecting the license to not being
26 renewed or reinstated. If a case settles, recovery of investigation and enforcement costs may be
27 included in a stipulated settlement.

28 ///

1 FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

2 (April 17, 2015 Criminal Convictions for Insurance Fraud, Tax Evasion & Grand Theft)

3 15. Respondent's license is subject to discipline under sections 490 and 4883(a) of the
4 Code in that she was convicted of crimes that are substantially related to the qualifications, duties,
5 and functions of a Registered Veterinary Technician. The circumstances are as follows:

6 a. On April 17, 2015, in a criminal proceeding entitled *People of the State of*
7 *California v. Susie Delcastillo Aviles, et al.*, in San Diego County Superior Court, case number
8 SCD235499, Respondent was convicted on her plea of guilty to violating seven counts of
9 Insurance Code section 11880(a), misrepresentation of a fact for the purpose of reducing the
10 premium, rate and cost of workers' compensation insurance issued by the State Compensation
11 Insurance Fund; Unemployment Insurance Code section 2117.5, failure to file a return and report
12 in a timely manner with the intent to evade a tax; and Penal Code section 487(a), grand theft in
13 excess of \$950, all felonies. Respondent admitted and the court found true the special allegations
14 that she and her codefendant committed two or more related felonies, a material element which
15 was fraud and embezzlement, which resulted in the loss by another person/entity of more than
16 \$100,000.00 but less than \$500,000.00 within the meaning of Penal Code section 186.11(a)(3),
17 and that Respondent's conduct resulted in the aggregate losses to all of the victims exceeding
18 \$65,000.00 within the meaning of Penal Code sections 12022.6(a)(1) and 12022.6(b).

19 b. As a result of the convictions, on June 22, 2015, Respondent was granted
20 five years probation to the court. She was ordered committed to the custody of the sheriff for 240
21 days, with pre-custody credit for one day. Imposition of the commitment was stayed pending
22 successful completion of probation which required Respondent perform 50 hours of community
23 service, participate in treatment/therapy/counseling, submit to a Fourth Amendment waiver, pay
24 fees and fines, and comply with felony probation terms. Respondent was ordered to pay
25 restitution in the amount of \$309,516 as follows: \$8,640 to the victim of grand theft, \$243,428 to
26 the State Compensation Insurance Fund, \$57,448 to the Employment Development Department,
27 and a county collection fee of \$46,427.40

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
