

This rulemaking by the Veterinary Medical Board amends and adopts sections in Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to establish a process for veterinary assistants to apply for a Veterinary Assistant Controlled Substances Permit (VACSP) in order to be granted authority to obtain and administer controlled substances under the direct or indirect supervision of a licensed veterinarian. This action implements BCP 4836.1 - 4836.4, [STATS. 2013 Chapter 515, section 26(SB 304)].

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 8/1/2016.
