## CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS



The Canine Rehabilitation Institute offers two certifications — both AAVSB R.A.C.E. approved. The [Canine Rehabilitation Therapist certification \(CCRT\)](#) is for Veterinarians and Physical Therapists. The [Canine Rehabilitation Assistant certification \(CCRA\)](#) is for Veterinary Technicians and Physical Therapist Assistants

### **Canine Rehabilitation Therapist (CCRT) — For Veterinarians and Physical Therapists**

The program includes three courses: [Introduction to Canine Rehabilitation](#), [The Canine Rehabilitation Therapist](#), and either [Canine Neurological Rehabilitation](#) or [Canine Sports Medicine](#).

CCRT students must complete a 40-hour internship at a CRI-approved practice.

The CCRT curriculum covers:

- Canine anatomy and physiology
- Conditions and injuries common in rehab patients
- Making assessments and treatment plans
- Therapeutic modalities
- The business of canine rehabilitation
- Legal and ethical considerations

### **Canine Rehabilitation Assistant (CCRA) — For Veterinary Technicians and Physical Therapist Assistants**

The program includes three courses: [Introduction to Canine Rehabilitation](#), [The Canine Rehabilitation Assistant](#), and either [Canine Neurological Rehabilitation](#) or [Canine Sports Medicine](#).

CCRA students must complete a 20-hour internship at a CRI-approved practice.

The CCRA curriculum covers:

- Canine anatomy and physiology
- Conditions and injuries common in rehab patients
- LASER, e-stim, ultrasound, and hydrotherapy equipment
- Therapeutic exercise
- Client education
- Legal and ethical considerations
