Because we offer veterinary and physical therapy professionals the premier training in canine rehabilitation available today. ### **We offer two certifications — both AAVSB R.A.C.E. approved.**

The Canine Rehabilitation Therapist (CCRT) is for Veterinarians and Physical Therapists. The Canine Rehabilitation Assistant (CCRA) is for Veterinary Technicians and Physical Therapist Assistants.

### **Our faculty members are top-notch.**

They are recognized leaders in their fields — and they love to teach. They have also managed busy referral practices, so they understand the business as well as the science of canine rehabilitation.

### **Our classes are small — a maximum of 25.**

Students benefit from the expertise of multiple instructors and teaching assistants. Hands-on activities are emphasized. Final exams are sent to students via email and collaboration is encouraged. To be certified, CCRT and CCRA students complete internships at CRI-approved practices.

### **Dogs — the live, tail-wagging variety — attend every class.**
