- (1) The disposal of waste material shall comply with all applicable state, federal, and local laws and regulations.
- (2) All drugs and biologicals shall be maintained, administered, dispensed and prescribed in compliance with state and federal laws.
- (3) Lighting adequate for the procedures to be performed in the vaccine clinic.
- (4) Table tops shall be of a material suitable for regular disinfecting, and cleaning, and shall be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- (5) A small animal mobile clinic shall have the ability and equipment to provide immediate emergency care at a level commensurate with the specific veterinary medical services it is providing.

These regulations are specific to the 'facility' where the vaccine clinic takes place--- all regulations related to the practice of veterinary medicine (VCPR, record keeping, etc) apply as usual.

Important Questions:

- 1) What level of documentation/record-keeping is appropriate for a vaccine clinic? Age of pet, Physical Exam findings, etc.
- 2) At what point does a 'vaccine clinic' become a mobile veterinary clinic---
 - vaccines only,
 - vaccines + flea control,
 - vaccines, flea control + heartworm testing and medication,
 - vaccines flea control, laboratory testing (heartworm, leukemia, FIV)
