Re: Proposed RVT School Regulations

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed language.

Comments:

Sec. 2065(b)

- (6) Add: Intubation and recovery of patients.
- (11) Avian and Exotic species,
- (13) Add: Immunodiagnostics
- (18) Pharmacology...and Pharmacy

Add: Administration of medications by all common routes.

Strongly recommend that there is a requirement a written Course Outline of Record for every course that includes: Course Objectives, Student Learning Outcomes, and a detailed Outline of the course content.

Recommend adding a provision that students are assessed at regular intervals using written Standard Criteria and that progress toward achievement of terminal objectives for each course be documented for every student.

Sec. 2065(f)

- (3) (f)(3) states the director must have a license (DVM or RVT) the exception stated here doesn't make sense...why would it allowed that they NOT be CA licensed?? Clarify...Licensed in another State and has applied for CA Licensing? Either way they must be licensed...

Sec. 2065(l)

Include a requirement for an estimate of the cost of the program including all fess, uniforms, equipment and books.
