An act to amend Sections ~~11506~~ 4800, 4804.5, 11506, and 22259 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to professions and vocations.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1243, as amended, Lieu. Professions and vocations.

(1) Existing law regulates the practice of veterinary medicine. Existing law, until January 1, 2016, provides for a Veterinary Medical Board within the Department of Consumer Affairs. Existing law, until January 1, 2016, authorizes the board to appoint a person exempt from civil service to be designated as an executive officer of the board, as specified.

This bill would extend those provisions until January 1, 2017.

(2) Existing law regulates the practice of common interest development managers, and makes those provisions effective only until January 1, 2015.

This bill would extend the effectiveness of those provisions until January 1, 2019, and subject those provisions to review by the appropriate policy committees of the Legislature. The bill would also delete an obsolete reference.

(3) Existing law establishes the California Tax Education Council, a nonprofit organization, and requires the council to register and regulate

tax preparers. Existing law makes those provisions effective only until January 1, 2015.

This bill would extend the effectiveness of those provisions until January 1, 2019.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

3 4800. (a) There is in the Department of Consumer Affairs a
4 Veterinary Medical Board in which the administration of this
5 chapter is vested. The board consists of the following members:

- 6 (1) Four licensed veterinarians.
- 7 (2) One registered veterinary technician.
- 8 (3) Three public members.

9 (b) This section shall remain in effect only until January 1, ~~2016~~
10 2017, and as of that date is repealed, unless a later enacted statute,
11 that is enacted before January 1, ~~2016~~ 2017, deletes or extends
12 that date.

13 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, the repeal of this section
14 renders the board subject to review by the appropriate policy
15 committees of the Legislature. However, the review of the board
16 shall be limited to those issues identified by the appropriate policy
17 committees of the Legislature and shall not involve the preparation
18 or submission of a sunset review document or evaluative
19 questionnaire.

20 SEC. 2. Section 4804.5 of the Business and Professions Code
21 is amended to read:

22 4804.5. The board may appoint a person exempt from civil
23 service who shall be designated as an executive officer and who
24 shall exercise the powers and perform the duties delegated by the
25 board and vested in him or her by this chapter.
