

## **THE VETERINARY MEDICAL BOARD IS ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS OF INTEREST FOR THE REGISTERED VETERINARY TECHNICIAN COMMITTEE**

The Registered Veterinary Technician Committee (RVTC) is a 5-member Advisory Committee to the Veterinary Medical Board (Board). Its membership is comprised of three RVTs, one veterinarian and one public member. Members are appointed for a four-year term and may serve two full four-year terms. In addition, a member may serve a partial term depending on when and whom they are replacing.

RVTC members are expected to attend four quarterly meetings per year (March, June, August, and November) in Sacramento, California. Members are paid \$100 per diem per day worked and travel expenses. Committee members are required to submit disclosure documents on Economic Conflicts of Interest with the Fair Political Practices Commission upon appointment.

Persons interested in becoming a member of the RVTC must have been licensed in the State of California for a minimum of five years preceding appointment and must provide the following documentation:

1. Personal background statement including your reasons for applying, an overview of your understanding of the function of a regulatory entity and what special qualifications the Board should consider in making its decision,
2. Current curriculum vitae or resume,
3. Letters of good standing from all states of licensure verifying no disciplinary action has been taken against your license, and
4. Letters of recommendation that focus on your qualities relating to serving on a consumer protection committee, examination preparation, an overall knowledge of the profession of veterinary technology.
