

Controlled Substance Reporting Requirements

DIRECT DISPENSING LOG INFORMATION – Veterinary Use Only

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 4170 and Section 11190 of the Health and Safety Code, all licensees who dispense Schedule II, III and IV controlled substances must provide the dispensing information to the Department of Justice on a weekly basis by using the Direct Dispensing Log.

The Direct Dispensing Log is designed to aid veterinarians in fulfilling Business and Professions Code Section 4170 as well as the Health and Safety Code Section 11190 reporting requirements.

Information must be submitted by mail to: CURES Program, P.O. Box 160447, Sacramento, CA 95816. **Do not submit forms to the Veterinary Medical Board.**

The log contains the following information:

- The prescriber's name, address, telephone number, license number, and federal controlled substance registration (DEA#).
- Date of dispensing.
- Numeric quantity of controlled substance dispensed.
- Drug name.
- NDC (National Drug Code) number of the controlled substance dispensed.
- Strength of the prescription.
- Client's full name.
- Client's date of birth (if available)
- Client's gender (Code: male=1/female=2).
- Client's address.
- Animal patient's name
- Reporting Month/Year.
- Date submitted.

Practitioners/prescribers are not required to report to CURES if they only administer the Schedule II, III and IV controlled substances.
