

**Title 16. Professional and Vocational Regulations
Division 20. Veterinary Medical Board**

Amend section 2010 of Division 20 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:

2010. Application.

(a) An application for eligibility evaluation for the California State Board (CSB) examination of the eligibility evaluation for the national examination shall be submitted to the board at its principal place of business on an application form and pursuant to instructions prescribed and provided by the board, (Veterinary Application, Form No. ~~25A01-25A-1~~, Rev. ~~07/2000-4/2008~~, 9/2010; Veterinary Application Instructions, Rev. 9/2010), accompanied by such evidence, statements, or documents as therein required, and filed with the board at its principal office at least ninety-five (95) days before the date fixed for the examination. The Board shall complete the eligibility evaluation and notify the candidate of eligibility and/or status.

Any applicant desiring to retake an examination shall submit to the board the appropriate application and fee at least ninety-five (95) days before the date fixed for the examination. Once eligibility is established, the candidate will be authorized to take the computer based examination. If an applicant fails their first scheduled examination, the applicant must reapply by submitting to the board required application forms and fees.

(b) An application for the registered veterinary technician examination shall be submitted on an application form and pursuant to instructions prescribed and provided by the board, (Registered Veterinary Technician Application, Form No. ~~26-4 26A-1~~, Rev. ~~04/98-7/2009~~, 9/2010; Registered Veterinary Technician Application Instructions, Rev. 9/2010), accompanied by such evidence, statements or documents as therein required, and filed with the board at its principal office at least sixty (60) days before the date fixed for the examination. The Board shall complete the eligibility evaluation and notify the candidate of eligibility and/or status. Once eligibility is established, the candidate will be authorized to take the computer based registered veterinary technician examination. If an applicant fails their first scheduled examination, the applicant must reapply by submitting to the board required application forms and fees.
