PROPOSED REGULATORY LANGUAGE

Updated Fees

Amend Sections 2070, 2071, and 2071.1 of Article 7 of Division 20 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) as follows:

§ 2070. Registration and Renewal Fees for Veterinarians, University License, Veterinary Premises, and Diversion Program.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 4905 of the code, the following fees are fixed by the board:

- (a) The application eligibility review fee for all examinations shall be \$350.00.
- ~~(b) The fee for the California state board examination shall be \$350.00.~~
- ~~(c)~~ The fee for the veterinary law examination shall be \$100.00.
- ~~(d)~~ The initial license fee for licenses issued for one year or more from the date on which they will expire shall be \$500.00.
- ~~(e)~~ The biennial renewal fee shall be \$500.00.
- ~~(f) The fee for a temporary license shall be \$250.~~
- ~~(g)~~ The university license application fee shall be \$350.00.
- ~~(h)~~ The initial license fee for a university license shall be \$500.00.
- ~~(i)~~ The biennial renewal fee for a university license shall be \$500.00.
- (j) The delinquency fee shall be \$50.00.
- (k) The annual initial fee for registration of a veterinary premises shall be \$400.00\$500.00.
- (l) The annual renewal fee for registration of a veterinary premises shall be \$400.00\$525.00.
- ~~(m) The fee for the Board's Diversion Program shall be \$2,000 per participant.~~
- ~~(n) The delinquency fee shall be \$50.00.~~

§ 2071. Application, Registration, Renewal, and Delinquency Fees Regarding Registered Veterinary Technicians and Approval of School or Institution Curriculum Fee.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section ~~4842.54~~4905 of the code, the following fees are fixed by the board:

- (a) The application eligibility review fee shall be ~~\$350.00~~\$225.00.
- ~~(b) The fee for the California veterinary technician examination shall be \$200.00.~~

- (~~eb~~) The initial registration fee for registrations issued for one year or more from the date on which it will expire shall be ~~\$350.00~~\$225.00.
- (~~dc~~) The biennial renewal fee shall be ~~\$350.00~~\$225.00.
- (~~ed~~) The delinquency fee shall be \$50.00.
- (~~fe~~) The biennial application fee for Board approval of the curriculum for training registered veterinary technicians by a school or institution, by a degree program pursuant to section 2065.6, or by a practical experience and education equivalent program pursuant to section 2068.5, shall be \$300.00.

§ 2071.1. Application, Permit, and Renewal Fees for Veterinary Assistant Controlled Substance Permits.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section ~~4836.2~~4905 of the code, the following fees are fixed by the board:

- (a) The application fee for the veterinary assistant controlled substance permit (VACSP) shall be ~~\$50.00~~\$100.00.
- (b) The initial VACSP fee for VACSPs issued for one year or more from the date the initial VACSP is granted shall be ~~\$50.00~~\$100.00.
- (c) The biennial renewal fee shall be ~~\$50.00~~\$100.00.
