## UPDATED INFORMATION

The Informative Digest and the Initial Statement of Reasons (ISOR) are included in the rulemaking file and incorporated as though set forth herein. The ISOR is updated as follows:

The 45-day public comment period ran from August 29, 2023 to October 23, 2023. The Veterinary Medical Board's (Board) Notice indicated the Board did not intend to hold a hearing on the matter, unless requested. The Board did not receive a request to hold a hearing on this rulemaking. The Board received two positive public comments.
