NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Veterinary Medical Board (Board) will hold a public hearing on the proposed regulatory action to amend Sections 2070 and 2071 of Article 7, Division 20, Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations, related to: Registration and Renewal Fees for Veterinarians, Veterinary Premises, and Diversion Program; and, Application, Registration and Renewal Fees Regarding Registered Veterinary Technicians.
