Inspections

On November 17, 2025, Board staff held a quarterly round table meeting for Inspectors. Mobile inspection application issues were discussed as well as potential future enhancements. The next Inspection round table meeting is tentatively scheduled for February following the release of the iOS MIP application. The Office of Information Systems staff along with the Tyler Technologies, Inc staff continue working on this update, however, the release has been delayed.

Ongoing recruitment efforts for an inspector in the Bay Area have resulted in the hiring of the Board's newest inspector, Sara Hullinger. Ms. Hullinger graduated from Purdue University with degrees in Criminal Justice and Veterinary Technology and has been a Registered Veterinary Technician since 2014. She has worked in various veterinary settings including an emergency care center. She is currently a veterinary MRI technician at a Bay Area practice.

Intake

Intake staff have continued to process complaints well below the ten-day cycle time target, with investigations opened in about four days. As mentioned in prior meetings, Intake staff continued their focus on requesting records for cases in which records have not been obtained through the month of October. By December, the number of cases pending at Intake was two cases. However, since one of the two Intake technicians recently promoted, this number may rise temporarily as management works to fill the vacant position as soon as possible.

Investigations

At the end of December 2025, the Board had 3,538 cases pending, which is slightly above where it started at the beginning of FY 24/25 - as the Board had a couple vacancies in the enforcement unit. Since October the Enforcement Analysts have focused on requesting records for all pending standard of care cases. The goal of this project is to avoid records from reaching the three-year retention mark specified in law as well as obtaining a realistic number of cases that require a Consultant review and

potentially Subject Matter Expert (Expert) review. This resulted in a slight decrease in the number of closures in November. Additionally, there are currently an Enforcement Analyst, Enforcement Technician and Special Investigator position vacancies which management is working to fill as soon as possible.

Subject Matter Expert (Expert) Program

On November 18, 2025 and November 20, 2025, the Board held round tables for its Consultants and Experts (respectively). During these meetings, a variety of topics were covered, including:

- Not posting anything case-related to social media.
- Reminders about Expert requirements and clinical practice experience.
- Examples and information on passive vs. active voice in reports.
- Information on additional resource materials for Experts to obtain from the Board.
- Charges for prescriptions.
- Attributing standard of care departures accurately when work is performed by supporting staff (Registered Veterinary Technicians, Veterinary Assistant Controlled Substance Permit holders, and non-license holding staff)
- Relief veterinarians' responsibility for work performed by supporting staff
- Invoice reminders

Probation

The Probation Monitors are actively investigating 26 pending enforcement complaints against 12 probationers. Currently, there are three Petitions for Early Termination and one Petition for Reinstatement pending.

Since the last update, five licensees began probation, bringing the number of current probationers to 60, seven of which are tolled.



